Each year the NSFSI bestows the Instructor of the Year award on a deserving instructor. To be eligible for this award an instructor must meet the following criteria:

1. Must live in Nebraska.
2. Be a current member of the NSFSI.
3. Must be an active instructor for a minimum a 3 years.
4. Eligible instructors may teach in any area of the fire related emergency services such as: fire, rescue, Ems, and related areas.

Recommendations for the Instructor of the Year **must** be in writing and E-mailed or sent through the postal service to the: **NSFSI, P.O. Box 5283, Grand Island, Nebraska 68802-5283** or nesociety@hotmail.com, by **January 10, 2010**. Recommendations will then be forwarded to the Instructor of the Year committee for consideration.

Please include the following information about the candidate: Name, address, phone number, e-mail address, which organization the person teaches with/for, any positions that he/she holds in the organization, years as an instructor, subjects taught. Please include a statement detailing why this candidate is outstanding and deserving of this award.

The nomination should also include your name, your relationship to the person you are nominating and a contact number that you can be reached in case the committee needs additional information.

The Instructor of the Year committee will make their decisions based on the information received and the award will be given annually during the Les Lukert Winter Conference in February.
